SEROLOGICAL EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED ON BLOOD SAMPLES FROM MIKE GLYNN, EXHIBITS #169B(1) AND #169B(2), DISCLOSED THE PRESENCE OF BLOOD GROUP O, SECRETOR STATUS INCONCLUSIVE.

SEROLOGICAL EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED ON BLOOD SAMPLES FROM WILLIAM MCREYNOLDS, EXHIBITS #179C(1) AND #179C(2), DISCLOSED THE PRESENCE OF BLOOD GROUP AB, NON-SECRETOR INDICATED.

SEROLOGICAL EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED ON BLOOD SAMPLES FROM LINDA PUGH, EXHIBITS #183(A) AND #183(B), DISCLOSED THE PRESENCE OF BLOOD GROUP A,
